Letter From Event Committee



Pablove was built on our impassioned desire to find a cure, and to allow kids living with cancer the opportunity to *still be kids* while undergoing treatment. It is our mission to:


Improve the lives of children living with cancer through the arts

What grew out of our seed grants

Since 2011, we've invested \$2.5 Million in Powered by Pablove seed grants. Our researchers have leveraged this initial funding to secure an additional \$10 Million in federal grants – a total impact of \$12.5 Million and an ROI of 400%


